



## **Curved Wall**




Cut, score and test fold the model pieces as shown above.



Glue the two side wall sections together.




Glue the opposite end as shown above. At this time your side walls should look like the picture and be in a roughly curved shape.




Glue one end tab of the top piece to the wall section as shown above and allow to dry fully before proceeding.








Finish gluing the top section to the wall piece a couple tabs at a time. Apply glue with a scrap of paper.



Flip your model over to insert a long tool to apply pressure to tabs from within as you glue them.




Once the top is dry, repeat with the bottom side.




The inner curved wall (mini curve) glues in the same way as its larger counterpart. Glue the side wall piece ends together and allow to dry.









Glue one end tab of the top piece and allow to dry. Then glue the remaining tabs using a scrap of paper to insert glue on the tabs and allow to dry. You can flip upside down and use a pencil to apply pressure from within if required.



Repeat with the bottom flap. If the bottom flap gets inserted too far, simply use your knife to pry it back out flush with the side walls.



The base section will be much sturdier if you glue it to foam core first.



Glue the completed curved wall sections to the base, being careful to keep the ends flush with the sides of the base.
