

#### Roll D100

- 1. Allodoxaphobia: The fear of opinions. Being afraid of hearing what others think about you.
- 2. Samhainophobia: The fear of Halloween.
- 3. Photophobia: The fear of light caused by something medical in nature or a trauma.
- 4. Disposophobia: The fear of getting rid of items and creates extreme hoarding.
- **5.** Numerophobia: The fear of numbers and calculations.
- 6. Ombrophobia: The fear of rain and stormy weather.
- 7. Dracophobia: The fear of Dragon like things.
- 8. Thalassophobia: The fear of the ocean, open water, waves and vast watery spaces.
- 9. Scoleciphobia: The fear of worms. Often because of germs and unhygienic things.
- 10. Kinemortophobia: The fear of zombies and ghouls. Being afraid that their attack will turn you into one of them.
- 11. Myrmecophobia: The fear of ants.
- 12. Taphophobia: The fear of being buried alive by mistake and waking up in a casket underground.
- 13. Galeophobia: The fear of sharks in the water.
- 14. Athazagoraphobia: The fear of being forgotten or forgetting things.
- 15. Katsaridaphobia: The fear of cockroaches. Can lead to OCD.
- 16. Iatrophobia: The fear of doctors and things medical .
- 17. Pediophobia: The fear of creepy dolls.
- 18. Ichthyophobia: The fear of fish. Includes any kind of fish.
- 19. Achondroplasiaphobia: The fear of midgets and little people.
- 20. Mottephobia: The fear of moths.
- 21. Zoophobia The fear of animals. Applies to both dangerus and harmless animals.
- 22. Bananaphobia The fear of bananas. .
- 23. Sidonglobophobia: The fear of cotton balls or plastic foams.
- 24. Scelerophobia: The fear of crime, being afraid of burglars, attackers or crime in general.
- 25. Cibophobia The fear of food. May have developed by a bad food experience.
- 26. Phasmophobia: The fear of ghosts. Also known as Spectrophobia.
- 27. Equinophobia: The fear of horses.
- 28. Musophobia The fear of mice.
- 29. Catoptrophobia: The fear of mirrors. Being afraid of the reflection.
- 30. Agliophobia: The fear of pain. Being afraid something painful will happen.
- 31. Tokophobia: The fear of pregnancy involves giving birth or having kids.
- **32.** Pogonophobia: The fear of beards or being scared of bearded men.
- 33. Omphalophobia: The fear of belly buttons, or touching and/or looking at navels.

- 34. Pseudodysphagia: The fear of choking, often after a bad experience.
- **35.** Bathophobia: The fear of depths, or anything associated with depth (lakes, dungeons, tunnels, caves).
- 36. Cacomorphobia: The fear of fat people.
- 37. Gerascophobia: The fear of getting old.
- 38. Chaetophobia The fear of hair.
- 39. Nosocomephobia: The fear of medical establishments.
- 40. Ligyrophobia: The fear of loud noises. More than the normal instinctive noise fear.
- 41. Didaskaleinophobia: The fear of school and learning establishments.
- 42. Technophobia: The fear of technology is often induced by culture/religion.
- 43. Chronophobia: The fear of the future. A persistent fear of what is to come.
- 44. Spheksophobia: The fear of wasps.
- 45. Ergophobia: The fear of work and jobs. Often due to social anxiety.
- 46. Coulrophobia: The fear of clowns. It's no laughing matter.
- 47. Arachnophobia: The fear of spiders. Studies show this fear affects women four times more (48% women and 12% men).
- 48. Ophidiophobia: The fear of snakes.
- **49.**Acrophobia: The fear of heights. Five out of every 100 of the general population suffer from this phobia.
- 50. Agoraphobia: The fear of open or crowded spaces.
- 51. Cynophobia: The fear of dogs. This includes every type of dog.
- 52. Astraphobia: The fear of thunder and/or lightning.
- **53.** Claustrophobia: The fear of small spaces like small rooms and other enclosed spaces.
- 54. Mysophobia: The fear of germs.
- 55. Aerophobia: The fear of flying.
- 56. Trypophobia: The fear of holes is an unusual but very common phobia.
- 57. Carcinophobia: The fear of cancer.
- 58. Thanatophobia: The fear of death. Even talking about it can be hard.
- 59. Glossophobia: The fear of public speaking.
- 60. Monophobia: The fear of being alone. Even while sleeping or eating.
- 61. Atychiphobia: The fear of failure. It is the single greatest barrier to any success.
- 62. Ornithophobia: The fear of birds. Individuals suffering from this may just fear one species (seagulls, pigeons etc.)
- 63. Alektorophobia: The fear of chickens.
- 64. Enochlophobia: The fear of crowds and large numbers of people.
- 65. Aphenphosmphobia: The fear of intimacy. Fear of being touched and love.
- 66. Trypanophobia: The fear of needles.

- 67. Anthropophobia: The fear of people. Being afraid of any people in any situation.
- 68. Aquaphobia: The fear of water. Being scared of water or being near water.
- 69. Autophobia: The fear of abandonment and being abandoned by someone.
- 70. Hemophobia The fear of blood. Even the sight of blood can cause a sufferer to pass out.
- 71. Gamophobia: The fear of commitment or being with someone to the end.
- 72. Hippopotomonstrosesquippedaliophobia The fear of long words.
- 73. Xenophobia: The fear of the unknown. Fearing anything or anyone that is strange, alien or foreign.
- 74. Vehophobia The fear of driving a vehicle. Carts, wagons etc.
- 75. Basiphobia: The fear of falling.
- 76. Achievemephobia: The fear of success. The opposite to the fear of failure.
- 77. Theophobia: The fear of Gods or religion.
- 78. Ailurophobia: The fear of cats. This is also known as Gatophobia.
- 79. Metathesiophobia: The fear of change.
- 80. Globophobia: The fear of balloons.
- 81. Nyctophobia: The fear of darkness. Being afraid of the dark or the night is very common.
- 82. Androphobia: The fear of men. Usually seen in young females, but it can also affect adults too.
- 83. Phobophobia: The fear of fear itself.
- 84. Philophobia: The fear of love. Scared of falling in love or emotions that follow.
- 85. Triskaidekaphobia: The fear of the number 13 and the bad luck that follows it.
- 86. Emetophobia: The fear of vomiting and the fear of the gag reflex.
- 87. Gephyrophobia: The fear of bridges and the crossing of even the tinyest bridge.
- 88. Entomophobia: The fear of bugs and insects, also related to Acarophobia.
- 89. Lepidopterophobia: The fear of butterflies and most winged insects.
- 90. Panophobia The fear of everything and the fear that terrible things are going to happen.
- 91. Podophobia: The fear of feet.
- 92. Paraskevidekatriaphobia: The fear of Friday the 13th.
- 93. Somniphobia The fear of going to sleep. Being terrified of what might happen when you fall asleep.
- 94. Gynophobia: The fear of women. May occur if you have "mommy" issues.
- 95. Apiphobia: The fear of bees.
- 96. Koumpounophobia The fear of buttons. Clothes with buttons are to be avoided.
- 97. Anatidaephobia: The fear of ducks.
- 98. Pyrophobia: The fear of fire.
- 99. Ranidaphobia: The fear of frogs.
- 100. Ovinophobia: The fear of sheep and goats.
