Designing Coral Reefs

The above three tables can be used to create that most unique of ocean areas - the coral reef.

Since the reef itself is a living thing start by rolling 1d4+2 times on the stationary table to determine the major structure of the reef itself. Then populate this structure with 1d4+4 rolls on the fish table and 1d4 rolls on the animals table. This produces a list of the common fish and other animals that can be found in the vicinity of the reef.
